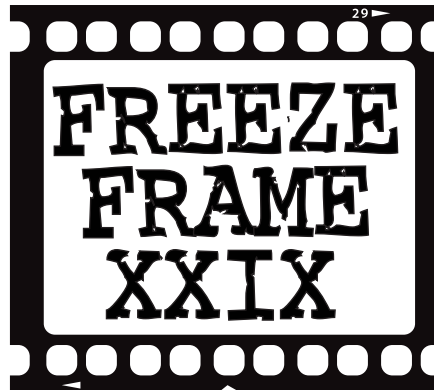

MONTREAL CANADA BOUND Fall 2015!

The dates have been set for our Canada trip!
October 22nd thru 27th

And we've narrowed it down to 2 hotels in the old port area located in the heart of the art community. Looking into flights out of Lafayette (& New Orleans) but, you can make your own arrangements or go through our LAA member travel agent, Janet Theriot.

More details coming soon along with a brochure! While we're still busy planning, here's an idea of the trip's itinerary:

Day 1: Meet/dinner at restaurant on Rue St. Paul to distribute packets with tickets, info, etc. Days 2-5: Private lunch at the Montreal Museum of Fine Art with time for viewing and shopping then across the street to the Canadian artist museum; "Illumination" at Notre Dame Basilica (a must see), Artist Co-ops, Inuit Art Galleries and time to explore on your own. Cirque de Soleil, Musee des Beaux Arts, and lots of other things to do and see. Of course you'll need a passport! You may choose to stay elsewhere, but approximately \$225CA/night will be the fees for the hotel we select for the 5 nights. A Continental breakfast is included with hotel room. Airfare is your choice too (you may elect to use air miles accumulated). We recommend the Delta flight from LFT leaving early am on the 22nd and arriving early pm in Montreal (returning late am, arriving late pm LFT on 27th) at \$780 per person w/tax & fees. Transportation provided from the airport to the hotel (fee to be determined) or you can make your own arrangements. All museum and tickets to various events will be optional and a list of fees will follow (this is only a guess estimate - if you elect to do everything, it will be approximately \$3,000). If interested please let us know asap! 269-0363 We have a definite 4 and will take a min of 10 and max of 20 people. Guests are also invited! **Allons Y'all!**
