Just recently I was talking to a friend, a fellow artist, who mentioned he had a stash of material on hand that he could use to produce new creative work - art that is very unique and in his style. But, he just didn't feel like making art. He didn't know why, but he just wasn't in that mood. I told him, "you're in the funk". That's what I call it and I get it about once a year. 



Applications Open for the LDOA Individual Artist Relief Grant

Deadline: April 16, 2021 The purpose of this grant is to provide relief directly to individual LA Artists impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic or other natural disasters that affected our state in 2020. The Louisiana Division of the Arts (LDOA) is partnering with 9 Regional Arts Councils throughout the state to administer these grants. Grant award amounts will be up to \$1,500 each. Funds are limited and will be awarded to eligible applicants up until funding capacity is reached in each region. Eligible artists must be a LA resident and 18+ years old. Artists will be asked to demonstrate their artistic practice with a professional website/social media, resume or CV, and/or examples of their work and to describe the financial impact the pandemic/natural disasters had on them and their practice.
