

Slab construction starts by rolling out and creating smooth slabs of clay that are then formed around molds or shaped by hand. Additional decorative designs are pressed into the clay and/or attached to create a unique form. In this workshop, you will have the opportunity to build 2 slab constructed objects: a vessel, a wall-hanging, or a platter. We'll schedule a convenient time in the following week to glaze your pieces at Edward's home studio (where he'll do the firing). You'll then be notified to pick up your finished work at the LAA. Hour lunch break. All tools and supplies for the workshop will be provided.

FIRE UNDER THE OAKS An Alternative Firing Workshop at the Biloxi Center for Ceramics/Ohr O'Keefe Museum of Art February 10,11 & 12, 2023 Biloxi, MS.

Three legends of Southern Pottery: Randy Brodnax (Marble Falls, TX), Don Ellis (Farmington, NM) and Ron Wilson (San Antonio, TX) will provide 3 full days of instruction on a plethora of both traditional and modern alternative firing techniques including: Raku, naked raku, obvara, horse hair & feather, sagger firing, fuming with stannous & metal chlorides and interference mica techniques. Glow-worm wood fired cone 10 kiln firing.

Learn how to construct your own affordable downdraft barrel kiln. Spend a full day learning from each master potter over the three days and participate in firing your own bisqued pieces. Lunch provided, as well as snacks & beverages. Cost: \$650. fireundertheoaks.com.

Open Studio Acadiana Returns Nov 19 & 20 Registration open!






