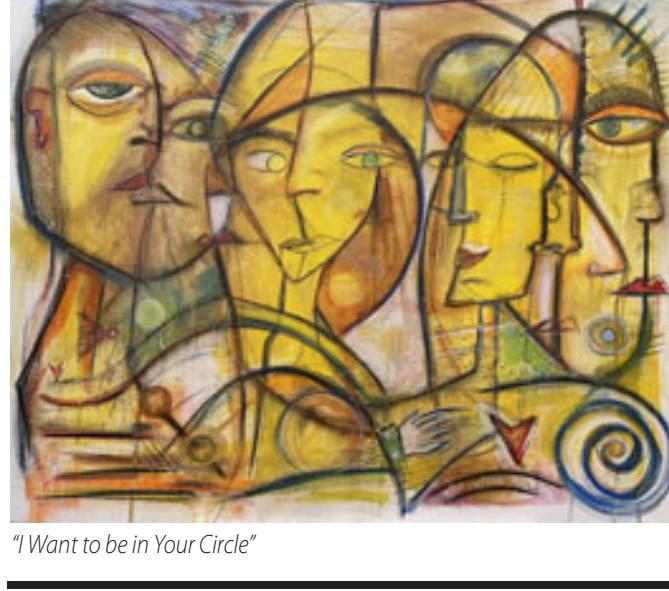


President's Blurb
